GRAND OPENING OF THE PERRY BEECHES BAPTIST CHURCH COMMUNITY HUB & CAFÉ

Councillor Darius Sandhu, Councillor for the ward of Oscott, officially opened Perry Beeches Baptist Church's Community Hub and Café on Saturday 13th May at 10am, by cutting the ribbon to the new facility.

Councillor Darius Sandhu said, "I'm absolutely delighted to be opening this much needed community café which will create a space where anyone from the local community is welcomed."



Pastor Tracy Sweet, Baptist Minister at Perry Beeches Baptist Church said, "We have been planning the café for a long time and a lot of work has gone into it. It's great to see our plans now a reality and we are excited to be supporting the local community with this new Community Hub and Café."



Over 300 people attended the opening and there were many stalls and activities for the community, such as bouncy castle, tombola, raffles, craft stall, bric-a-brac, face painting, a fire engine and much more until 3pm. Entry was free and those with a flyer also got a free drink and cake.



The aim of the Community Café is to not only support church members but the wider community. It is important to create a space where anyone is welcome to enjoy refreshments and conversations together.
