COMPASSION SUNDAY SERVICE



On Sunday 22nd September, Pastor Yvonne Brooks shared the good news with the church about Compassion UK, a Christian child development charity, working in partnership with local churches to release children from poverty in Jesus' name.


Compassion work in 29 countries partnering with 8,600 local churches within communities experiencing poverty.

They give children and young people the opportunity to thrive and reach their God-given potential, both now and into the future.

Compassion's child development programmes are holistic, and because they work in partnership with local churches who know their communities inside out, they are tailored to a child or young person's individual situation. Independent research shows they are highly effective, and now more than 2.3 million children globally are being released from poverty.

Compassion have been working with Perry Beeches Baptist Church and Pastor Brooks shared the important work Compassion were doing with communities, and also outlined progress with how Perry Beeches Baptist Church were getting on with their sponsored children as follows:

Jesus is at the centre of everything Compassion does. Their programmes show God's love to children living in poverty. Whilst Christ's love motivates Compasssion, they help children and families from all backgrounds, regardless of belief. LADIES CONFERENCE

On Saturday 28th September, thirty ladies joined the Mustard Seed Ladies Conference, hosted by Perry Beeches Baptist Church. The guest speaker was Rebecca Benstead from Christian Concern, whose vision is a society transformed at every level by the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They believe that Jesus Christ is good news for society and as relevant today as he has ever been. But we also know that it is becoming harder to be a Christian in the UK today.



Christian Concern campaigns in law, media, and politics for a Christian vision of society which protects life, promotes family, and preserves liberty. They engage in a wide range of issues, such as:

• **Beginning of Life**: They herald the dignity and worth of every human person from conception, and campaign against abortion and experimentation of unborn children.

- **End of Life**: They believe in better care and support for those in the closing stages of life, and campaign against all forms of assisted suicide and euthanasia.
- Marriage: They promote marriage as central to healthy families and communities, and challenge policies that dilute and dismantle it.
- **Gender**: They underline the reality and purpose of the distinction between male and female, and challenge transgender ideology.
- **Sexuality**: They recognise the goodness and power of God's gift of sex, and expose the bankruptcy of society's sexual autonomy, confusion and chaos.
- **Education**: They uphold the central role of parents in raising the next generation, and highlight that good education is built on a Christian worldview, especially in the areas of relationships and religion.
- **Christian Freedoms**: They protect the freedom to live for Jesus Christ in everyday life, and expose the challenges some Christians encounter.
- **Freedom of Speech**: They promote the freedom to speak of Jesus Christ and his pattern for life, and to express beliefs and viewpoints to which some people object.
- **Christian Society**: They remind society of the huge benefit that our Christian heritage has brought, and point to the resources that God's pattern provides for a flourishing future.
- **Secularism**: They expose secularism, which privileges atheism in public life, and squeezes out other religions and beliefs, including Christianity.
- **Islam**: Christian Concern seeks to love our Muslim neighbours, while honestly engaging with the true nature of Islam.
- **Church**: They encourage the Church to be confident in the good news for life given by God, and campaign for her freedom to declare it publicly.

Christian Concern work to make Jesus and his ways known, to protect the freedom to live and speak for him, and to empower Christians to be compassionate and courageous ambassadors.
